Undersøgelse af undervisning på engelsksprogede kandidatuddannelser

Tabelrapport undervisere

DANMARKS EVALUERINGSINSTITUT Dette bilag til EVA's evaluering af engelsksprogede kandidatuddannelser på danske universiteter, indeholder i tabelform resultaterne af den spørgeskemaundersøgelse EVA gennemførte blandt undervisere på engelsksprogede kandidatuddannelser i maj 2010.

Bilaget indeholder frekvenstabeller for svarfordelingerne på samtlige lukkede spørgsmål i de to spørgeskemaer. Med lukkede spørgsmål menes de spørgsmål hvor respondenterne udelukkende har kunnet besvare spørgsmålet ved at sætte en eller flere markeringer.

Som det fremgår af tabellerne, kan der være stor variation i antallet af respondenter der har besvaret de enkelte spørgsmål. Hvor mange der har besvaret et bestemt spørgsmål afhænger først og fremmest af om spørgsmålet er stillet til alle eller kun bestemte undergrupper af respondentgruppen.

Det er vigtigt at være opmærksom på at tabellerne som hovedregel kun indeholder de svarmuligheder som minimum én respondent har anvendt. Svarmuligheder i spørgeskemaet som ingen har anvendt, figurerer således ikke, med mindre det er meningsforstyrrende at udelade dem.

En nærmere redegørelse for den anvendte metode findes som appendiks bagerst i evalueringsrapporten.
